Thanks to Pastor & Mrs. Don Vanderhoof, in Nideggen, who hosted the team and lined up multiple ministry opportunities for us! We canvassed almost two whole towns. Also, we had special meetings on the Sunday before Christmas, on two Wednesdays and on Christmas Day. Several visiting families and individuals came to the services as well as those who regularly attend. Our team was able to present the Gospel, and encourage Christians through song, with handchimes, instrumental music, chalk art and preaching. Also, it was a direct answer to the Vanderhoof's prayers that a nursing home nearby allowed us to present a musical package for the folks there.

We enjoyed caroling as well. The people we sang to seemed very touched and thankful. One lady said she can't remember anyone ever caroling in that town before.

And thanks to Pastor & Mrs. Tom Hastings & Pastor & Mrs. Ed Taylor, in Bassenheim, for allowing us to participate in their Sunday morning service on Dec. 31st. A few days after that service, we heard that a visitor returned and asked the pastor's wife to show her how to be saved. Praise the Lord!

And we thoroughly enjoyed being able to run a children's Bible Club for them the last Wednesday morning before we left.

Also, an amazing thing happened as we were going through customs in the airport before flying home. One of the officers asked why we were in the country, so we told him we were helping churches by using music, etc. So he asked if our group would sing a song. So the young people sang John 3:16 in German right there in customs. Of course, everyone stopped long enough to listen. How thrilling!!!
