The Singapore/Malaysia Team

May 15 – June 19, 2018



The team had opportunities to minister in churches, in a Mission Conference, in Special Meetings, in a Children's VBS club, in Youth activities, by handing out literature on the streets, and by Evangelizing door to door. They served by using Music, Chalk Art, Drama, Testimonies, Teaching and Preaching. They spread the Gospel everywhere we went. We were in 7 different churches while there.

The US Western Team

July 8 – August 20, 2018



This team ministered in California, Utah, Wyoming, & Kansas. They did 6 VBS Programs, special meetings, passed out literature and were a witness everywhere they went. We were in 7 different churches.

It seemed like the devil fought us each step of the way with bus problems, but at the same time the Lord put people in our way at every turn to help us make it to each destination on time. We came to the conclusion that the devil didn't like the fact that young people were coming to Christ everywhere we went and that he was trying to prevent our journeys.

Our **first trial** was driving the last 200 miles into Barstow, CA. The bus overheated in the 112+ degree temperatures. After our arrival, a mechanic reset the motor to the generator, which we hoped would correct the problems. It was a great week, and we saw a number of children saved. But when we left Barstow, it took 21 hours to make our 6 hour trip to Delta, UT because of an air line leak and overheating. The Lord led us to a place in Las Vegas where they fixed the leak, but we still had the overheating problem. After finally limping our way into Delta, the Lord sent us a man who did a temporary fix on the overheating issues by locking the fan clutch. The last day of VBS in Delta, we saw several children come to the Lord for salvation.

But when we returned to the RV park, to prepare to leave the next morning, we soon realized that **someone had tried to break into the bus** while we were gone. Fortunately they were unsuccessful. Even though they did a lot of damage to the lock, we knew that the Lord had protected us once again.

The small church we went to next, Santaquin Baptist Church, just happened to have a man who is a locksmith. Wow, God is good. Dennis was able to totally rework and fix the lock, so it works better than it ever has!

On the way to Thayne, WY our air bags were leaking, but we made it anyway. With the Lord's help we did 2 VBS programs every day in 2 different towns. Our next stop was Pinedale, WY, where we did another VBS and more young people were saved. And we were able to put on 3 new airbags.

And the list goes on. We had a hole in the antifreeze line, which Blake fixed. We made it to Medicine Lodge without too much of a problem. We did our last VBS. And we had to order and put on a new fan motor for the generator which was part of the problem ever since Barstow, CA. On the way home we had to change the fuel filter about 100 miles from home. We ended up with a total of about \$2000 of repairs and 5200 miles of travel. Whew!!! But we saw God's protection following us each step of the way!!
