December 14, 2018 – January 5, 2019

We began at our home on December 14th with a few days of intense training and practice of vocal music, handchimes, testimonies, VBS skills, teaching, puppets, soulwinning, etc. We flew to Antigua on December 18th. There were some unexpected problems along the way, but in each situation the Lord took care of us and answered our prayers. Thanks to all of you that were praying for us.
