As you may have already assumed, the airlines canceled our Japan/Philippines trip that was scheduled for May 15 through June 23, 2020 because of Covid-19. We are postponing this trip until May and June of 2021 instead.

US West Team: June 10 – August 11, 2020

Currently we are still planning to take a team to the US West this summer. But the dates have changed and the team members have changed. Most of the ones that were on the Japan/Philippines team have decided to travel on the US West team instead.



Please pray for the U.S. West team. We realize the Lord may have different plans for this team as well, but we believe at this time that we should continue planning and preparing to help the church planters in the West. There is a great need to come alongside these men of God to give out the Gospel and the hope of salvation to the many people that have no hope during these troubled times.

Also, pray that two more people will step forward to join with us on this great calling to spread the Word in the West and also to encourage other believers.

On June 10th we begin our boot camp in our home to train the team for their ministry this summer. After a week of intense training, the team will begin the bus trip out west. We plan to help at least 7 different pastors and minister in 4 different states; New Mexico, Utah, Colorado, and Wyoming.

There will be opportunities to Preach, Teach Bible lessons, do tract distribution, do vocal and instrumental music, act out a drama, give testimonies, use puppets, play handchimes, and do chalk art with a Gospel message.

The team will be working with all age groups in Church Services, Children's Bible Clubs, Special Meetings, and Youth Activities.

The young people will have hands-on training and experience in serving the Lord for wherever He leads them in the future at home or abroad.
